





Sprint Length	Sprint Planning Time Box

4 weeks	8 hours








Sprint Planning Meeting




Sprint Execution

Sprint execution takes up the majority of time spent in each sprint




Sprint Execution Overview



Potentially shippable = validated learning


Potentially shippable ≠ shipped


Illustration of "Done"

Timeboxed to be no more than 1 hour per week of sprint duration




